



Christmas tree hat.

Abbreviations: k=knit, p=purl, s=slip stitch, pssso=pass slip stitch over the knit stitch. K2tog= knit the next 2 stitches together as one.

Using size 5mm needles and 2 strands of DK wool.

Cast on 60 sts and k1 p1 rib 12 rows. Change to green 3 strands of DK wool and knit1 row, purl1 row.

Cast on 5 stitches, knit these 5 and the next 12 stitches, turn. Cast on 5 stitches and purl 22 stitches.

K1, s1, pssso knit to the last 3 stitches K2tog k1. Purl 1 row. Repeat these 2 rows till 10 stitches remain.

Cast on 4 stitches. Knit these 4 and the next 10 stitches. Turn. Cast on 4 stitches purl these and purl to the end.

K1,s1 pssso knit to the last 3 stitches k2tog k1. Purl 1 row. Repeat these 2 rows till 8 stitches remain.

Cast on 3 stitches knit these 3 and the next 8 stitches. Turn. Cast on 3 stitches , purl these and purl to the end.

Repeat till 4 stitches remain. S1, k1 pssso k2 tog. P2 tog. Cut wool and pull through the loop.

Rejoin the wool to the other stitches and complete 4 more tree shapes using sections of 12 stitches with cast on stitches for the branches.

Sew together along the shaped edge of the branches and down the side of the ribbing.
