



Daffodil flower.

Made using Double Knitting wool and size 10/3.25mm needles.

Petals (make6)

Cast on 2 stitches. Knit 1 row. Purl row: increase 1 stitch in each stitch. (4sts) Knit row: increase 1 stitch into first and last stitch. (6sts) Purl row: increase 1 stitch into first and last stitch. (8sts) Knit 1 row, purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row. Cast off all stitches.

Trumpet.

Cast on 14 stitches knit 1 row, purl 1 row, knit 1 row, and purl 1 row. Knit 2 together, wool forward, knit 2 together wool forward knit 2 together to the end of the row.

Knit 1 row, purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row. Cast off. Fold in half so that the knit 2 together wool forward holes create a picot (bumpy) edge.

Sew the side seams together to form a trumpet shape. Leave the hole at the base open so that the centre patch can be sewn on to show through.

Centre patch.

Cast on 4 stitches. Knit 4 rows. Cast off.

To make up.

Sew the ends of the wool into the back of each petal. Lay one petal slightly over the top of the other, and sew together. Continue together in this manner until all 6 petals are sewn together in a chain. Then sew the first one to the last one, so that it creates a circle. Sew the centre patch over the centre hole. Stitch the trumpet (picot upper most) to the base of the flower. If you are making the brooch, sew the flower onto the brooch back.
